General Data Protection Regulations

The General Data Protection Regulations were introduced in May 2018. This requires the society to obtain permission from members to hold and use personal information.

This information is your name, postal address, telephone number and email address. This information will be held securely by the Chair, Secretary and Treasurer of BHS in paper form and electronically. This will not be shared with third parties without your permission. If you wish to check, this can be arranged via the officers.

Your postal address is used to supply the newsletters and official correspondence from the committee, which are part of the membership benefits.

Emails will be used to circulate relevant information from the society and other organisations such as Wirral Archives, and requests for help with matters relating to history.

The information will be held as long as you remain a member of the Society. In the event that membership is not renewed, your details will be destroyed at the annual review after 12 months.
